Knowledge is Power—the Power of Pysanky

The following optional items can be accumulated over time and added to your class set after you have acquired the basic supplies of beeswax, kistkas and dyes.

These also make nice gifts or rewards for a job well-done.



More Money Saving Tips for Teachers

- #1—Use tight fitting lids to avoid evaporation.
- #2—Freeze your dyes to avoid mold.
- #3—Re-use your old dyes.
- #4—Add vinegar to dyes to rejuvenate their dyeing power.
- #5—Do not pay taxes such as PST, GST or HST when you purchase from www.babasbeeswax.com.
- #6—Get grants from www.artstarts.com.
- #7—Share dyes amongst groups of students.
- #8—2 students can share 1 beeswax.

DVDs—stimulate your class with an audio and visual introduction to the history and culture of the unique pysanka, and to reinforce the technique

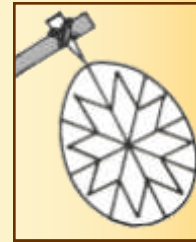
Puzzles—another way to learn through a fun group activity

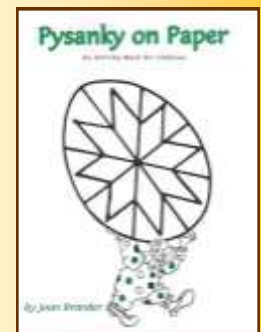

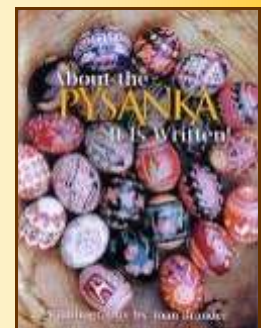
